FAKE AUCTION PAPERS

- Have you ever received an auction offer of choice **vehicles** through Facebook, or any other social media platforms?
- Was the price ridiculously low?
- Was it supposedly from the Nigeria Customs Service?

If your answer to these questions is YES, then you might be a potential victim of internet fraudsters. They use many ploys, but the most popular is using fake Facebook accounts opened in the name the **Comptroller-General of Customs, Dikko Inde Abdullahi**.

You are therefore deceived to believe that you are chatting with the “Comptroller - General of Customs” who might even refer you to an Officer in Some Border or any department of the Service.

Beware, the discussions that will eventually lead to a request that you pay some money into some private account is pure scam!

Many have been deceived.

Many have been scammed.

They are fraudulent. Don't patronize them.

The Nigeria Customs Service does not conduct auction sales of vehicles or any goods via Facebook or any other online platform
