## INVITATION TO TENDER FOR DRUGS AND OTHER HOSPITAL ITEMS FOR NIGERIA CUSTOMS SERVICE MEDICAL UNIT.

### 1.0 INTRODUCTION

In compliance with the requirements of the Public Procurement Act (2007) of the Federal Government of Nigeria, the Nigeria Customs Service is inviting competent Pharmaceutical companies and Hospital Consumable suppliers to tender for the under listed Projects:

These interested and competent pharmaceutical companies MUST be from within the pre-qualified contractors for 2016 Capital Projects by the Nigeria Customs Service.

### 2.0 ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- (i) Evidence of registration with Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC) by inclusion of Certificate of incorporation.
- (ii) Evidence of compliance with Federal Inland Revenue Service by inclusion of Tax Clearance Certificate for the last three years (2015, 2014 and 2013) receipts not acceptable.
- (iii) Evidence of compliance with National Pension Commission (PENCOM) Act 2014 by inclusion of Compliance Certificate.
- (iv) Evidence of compliance with Industrial Training Fund Act 2011 by inclusion of Compliance Certificate.
- (v) Evidence of registration with Bureau of Public Procurement (BPP) on the National Database of Contractors, Consultants and Service Providers.
- (vi) Evidence of financial capability supported with Bank reference and commitment from a reputable bank.

- (vii) Detailed Company profile with curriculum vitae of key Officers/Professional Personnel including photocopies of relevant professional qualifications.
- (viii) Verifiable evidence (copies of letter of awards and completion certificates) of successful completion of similar jobs in the last Five (5) years.
- (ix) Premises registration with Pharmacist Council of Nigeria.
- (x) Annual practice License issued to the Superintendent Pharmacist by the Pharmacist Council on Nigeria

Note: (ix) and (x) does not apply to Lot 4 and 5.
